






COVID-19: The dawn of 4IR-a New Endless Frontier











Yearly unemployment rate change, 2019-2020




COVID-19 exacerbating existing economic inequality across the globe




New jobs and new skills for 4IR era



• By embracing the original responsibilities of pathbreakers, governments will open new possibilities of the 4IR.






Concerns with Job Displacement by Al
